- One free half day weekly and on weekends, and a 1- or 2-day midtour break
- Average of 4-7 nights with each host family
- Maximum of 3 club meetings per week

5. I understand that predeparture documents for my district's GSE team must be submitted to The Rotary Foundation at least 45 days prior to the scheduled travel date. I understand that for exchanges between pilot and non-pilot districts, the non-pilot districts must follow GSE regulations and the pilot districts must meet Future Vision guidelines. Delays in submission will result in cancellation of travel for my district's GSE team. I will notify the GSE Department at The Rotary Foundation should the dates of the exchange be modified for any reason.
6. I understand that the funding options for the GSE program have changed for the 2010-11/2011-12 years. A World Fund award is for a period of two consecutive years, with one team traveling in the first year and the partner team traveling in the second consecutive year. However, districts may allocate funds from the District Designated Fund in order to exchange in the same program year. World Fund Awards do not accumulate from year to year and cannot be donated to another district.
